AzNN Exception Guidance for Recipe and Nutrient Standards for Food Pantries, Commodities, and Emergency Food Programs

- 1. Recipes used for food pantries, commodities, and emergency food programs should meet AzNN Recipe Nutrient Standards¹ when possible.
- 2. A. Contractors are allowed to use recipes from alternate sources that do not meet the AzNN Recipe Nutrient Standards only when providing recipes intended to accompany the specific and limited food items provided by food pantries, commodities, and emergency food programs.

B. Reputable sources², such as USDA materials, are the preferred resources for alternate recipes to complement these programs. Such resources include, but are not limited to:
